- Your company _____ (redevelop) land that it owns just five years ago, but since then all the surrounding land has been filled with much more modern developments.
- The CEO _____ (decide) at the end of last year to slowly decentralise power to local branches but a new CEO has joined this month and wants to bring power back to the head office.
- The market share of one of your competitors _____ (expand) by more than 300% in the last twelve months.
- Smoking was permitted inside the office until January this year but then it was banned. Since then, the only local café _____ (close) its smoking area.

Work together to fill all the gaps above with the correct tenses (Present Perfect or Past Simple).

Hint: Eight should be Present Perfect and six should be Past Simple.

- The CEO decided at the end of last year to slowly decentralise power to local branches but a new CEO has joined this month and wants to bring power back to the head office.
- The market share of one of your competitors has expanded by more than 300% in the last twelve months.
- Smoking was permitted inside the office until January this year but then it was banned. Since then, the only local café has closed its smoking area.
