

## Like and don't like things in common games

### Like and don't like things in common game

Say a true sentence starting with "I like..." or starting with "I don't like..." If your partner feels the same way, you get one point (including if you have the same negative feelings). If your partner doesn't feel the same way, you get no points.

#### Scoring guide and suggested reactions

<b>++</b> = So do I./ Me too./ I like... too.	<b>+x</b> = Really? I don't./ Really? I don't like...
<b>xx</b> = Neither do I./ Me neither./ I don't like... either.	<b>x+</b> = Really? I like...
<b>= 1 point</b>	<b>= 0 points</b>

#### Possible topics

Share one thing in common and see if other people in the class have the same feelings. Then ask about topics above you don't understand, sharing your feelings each time.

### Like and don't like differences game

Play the opposite game, getting one point if your partner doesn't feel the same way and no points if your partner feels the same way.

### Like and don't like things in common coin game

Play the same game, but first flip a coin to see if you should make a positive or negative statement.

**Heads = one point for finding a positive thing in common**

**Tails = one point for finding a negative thing in common**

### Like and don't like comparisons coin game

Play the same game, but this time flip a coin first. If you get heads, you get one point if you have the same feelings. If you get tails, you play the opposite game with one point for finding things that you don't have in common.

**Heads = 1 point for things in common**

**Tails = 1 point for differences**
