

## Nationality words stress maze games

### Nationality words stressed on the first syllable maze game

Trace a route through the maze below by following only the country words which change into nationality words that are stressed on the first syllable, starting from the top-left corner word "India" (because the nationality word is "INdian", stressed on the first syllable). You can't jump over squares and you can only move vertically or horizontally (meaning up, down, left or right), not diagonally. You should finish somewhere on the right-hand side of the maze, with an unbroken line of squares between the start and finish.

*Test each other on the words above:*

- Read out a nationality word and see if your partner can tell you which syllable is stressed
- Read out a country word and see if your partner can say the nationality word with the correct stress and say which syllable is stressed
- Hum a stress pattern and help your partner come up with suitable nationality words, giving them hints like the first letter and where the countries are if they get stuck

### Nationality words stressed on the second syllable maze game

Trace a route through the maze by following only the country words which change into nationality words that are stressed on the second syllable, starting from the top-left corner word “China” (because the nationality word is “ChiNESE”, stressed on the second syllable). You can’t jump over squares and you can only move up, down, left or right, not diagonally. You should finish somewhere on the right-hand side of the maze, with an unbroken line of squares between the start and finish.

- Hum a stress pattern and help your partner come up with suitable nationality words, giving them hints like the first letter and famous things from that place if they get stuck
