Past Simple sentence completion bluffing game

Fill at least half of the sentences below with a mix of true and not true information. Read out your sentences for the other students to try to guess which are true, perhaps after asking you for more information.

three times yesterday.
last week/ month/ year.
last week/ month/ year
yesterday but I haven't today.
the day before yesterday but I didn't yesterday
last month but I haven't this month.
last week and it was horrible.

at a festival.
a computer earlier this year.
